# Embroidery It

Machine embroidery designs so you can be creative daily and live life beautifully

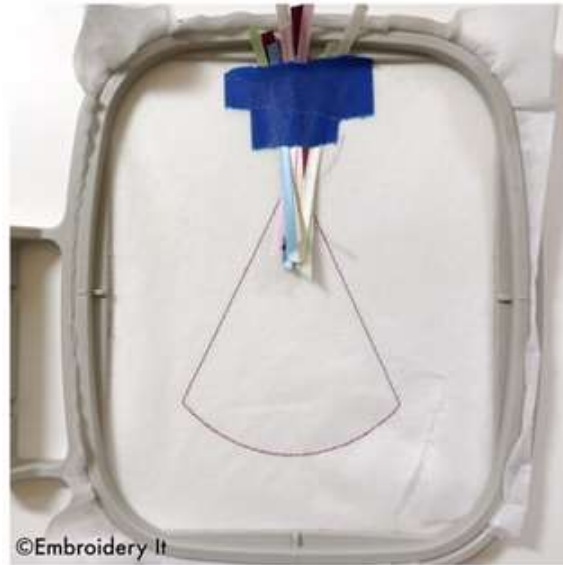


### Supplies

- Clean tear-away stabilizer
- 2 – 4 x 4” pieces of coordinating cotton
- Narrow ribbon
- Tape – I use painters tape

### Instructions:

1. Using your 4 x 4 hoop, hoop the stabilizer. Stitch the first color. This is your placement line. It will also show you where to place your ribbon.  
\*\*Cut approximately 10 pieces of ribbon 3” long for the party hat.  
\*\*Cut 2 pieces of ribbon 8” long for the balloons.



2. Tape ribbon in place
3. Place 1 piece of fabric over the placement line. Tape in place if necessary. I usually just hold carefully with my fingers for the first few stitches and stitch the next color which tacks the fabric down.



4. Remove hoop from machine but do NOT unhoop and trim close to the stitching line being careful not to clip any ribbons.
5. Return hoop to machine and the next color is the placement line for the second applique fabric.
6. Place cotton fabric over the placement line. Tape in place if necessary. The next color tacks down the cotton fabric.



7. Remove hoop from machine but do NOT unhoop. Trim close to the stitching line being careful not to clip any ribbons.
8. Stitch any remainder decorative stitching and border.
9. If stitching onto a shirt or other item, stop now and eliminate the eyelets which are the final color.
10. Otherwise, stitch the eyelets.
11. Punch holes in the eyelets to string banner items together.
